



**Ida High School
Craft Show
Rules and Regulations**

Please Read and Print for Reference

- 1) Exhibitors accept full responsibility for any loss, injury, or damage to persons or personal property that may be sustained while on said property. Christmas in Ida Festival will exercise every possible care and precaution but will assume no responsibility whatsoever for any property in the exhibit areas, on the premises, or in any of the parking areas.
- 2) To have a true craft show, we will not accept new applications for home party plans or sales of non-craft items. Our current non-craft vendors that have continued to participate will be accepted. As these non-craft vendors leave the show, they or other non-craft vendors will not be accepted.
- 3) Open flames are strictly prohibited.
- 4) No caustic chemicals allowed in the school or church buildings.
- 5) **Vendors must supply their own tables and chairs.**
- 6) Boundary lines for crafters are not to be moved.
- 7) Crafter displays may not exceed the boundary lines of their space.
- 8) Please be considerate of your fellow crafters that are next to you. Make sure there is a passage that can be used to get in and out of the space.
- 9) Show time is 8:30am to 2:30pm. The parade line up starts at 3:30pm in the school parking lot, so please try to be completely out by then. You cannot leave your vehicle in the parking lot.
- 10) If you want to keep the same space you are in currently, then it is advised that you pay for next year's show before the end of the current show. All applications will be date and time stamped for the following year as they are submitted. By doing so, you will most likely be able to keep your same space.
- 11) For those who would like to change their spot, you may put in your request with your completed application and fees. Applications and spaces shall be held until January 31. Unsold spaces shall be opened to new applicants on Feb. 1. Attempts shall be made to provide the requested spaces.
- 12) An application will not be approved unless full payment is submitted with application.
- 13) At the end of the show please use trash containers for all waste. It is also appreciated if you would pull up the blue floor tape around your booth.
- 14) Christmas in Ida reserves the right to site final placement space at the craft shows.
- 15) Electricity is limited. If you need electricity you will need to bring your own extension cords and power strips. Electricity is not guaranteed.
- 16) Any disruptive or non-compliant crafter will be directed to leave the building and ground.
- 17) Vendors shall not leave before 2:30 pm.
- 18) Make a copy of your application for yourself before you submit it.
