Rules and Regulations**

Please Read and Print for Reference

- 1) Exhibitors accept full responsibility for any loss, injury, or damage to personal property that may be sustained while on said property. Christmas in Ida Festival will exercise every possible care and precaution but will assume no responsibility whatsoever for any property in the exhibit areas, on the premises, or in any of the parking areas.
- 2) To have a true craft show, we will not accept new applications for home party plans or sales of non-craft items. Our current non-craft vendors that have continued to participate will be accepted. As these non-craft vendors leave the show, they or other non-craft vendors will not be accepted.
- 3) If you want to keep the same space you are in currently, then it is advised that you pay for next year's show before the end of the current show. All applications will be date and time stamped for the following year as they are submitted. By doing so, you will most likely be able to keep your space in the same place.
- 4) For those who would like to change their space, you may put in your request with your completed application and fees. Applications and spaces shall be held until January 31. Unsold spaces shall be opened to new applicants on Feb. 1. Attempts shall be made to provide the requested spaces.
- 5) Christmas in Ida **reserves the right** to site final placement space at the craft shows.
- 6) An application will not be approved unless full payment is submitted with application
- 7) Vendors shall not leave before 2:30 pm.
- 8) Tables and chairs:
 - ❖ **Ida School Show**- Vendor must supply their own chairs and tables
 - ❖ **Prine of Peace Church Show** – may provide their own chairs and tables or rent them as listed on the application
- 9) **Service Dogs**
 - ❖ **Service Dogs must be trained and certified for a specific task to assist a person with a disability.**
 - ❖ **Companion, therapy, emotional support, and facility dogs/animals are not allowed.**
- 10) Vendor Parking
 - ❖ **Ida School Parking Lot** – vendors may park on the east side of the school.
Important Note: Parade line-up starts at 3:30pm in the school parking lot, please try to be completely vacated then. You cannot leave your vehicle in the school parking lot during the parade line-up. Festival parking is available at the Ida East Road school entrance.
 - ❖ **Prince of Peace Church Parking Lot** - vendors may park anywhere. The festival shuttle bus service begins at 3:00pm.
- 11) Crafter displays may not exceed the vendor space boundary lines of their booth.
- 12) Boundary lines for crafters are not to be moved.
- 13) Please be considerate of your fellow crafters that are next to you. Make sure there is a passage that can be used to get in and out of the space.

- 14) Open flames are strictly prohibited.
- 15) No caustic chemicals allowed in school or church buildings.
- 16) Electricity is limited. If you need electricity you will need to bring your own extension cords and power strips. Electricity is not guaranteed.
- 17) Any disruptive or non-compliant crafter shall be directed to leave the building and grounds.
- 18) At the end of the show please remove your blue floor tape and use trash containers for all waste.
- 19) Make a copy of your application for yourself before you submit it.
